Narrative citations: Jackson (2019) and Sapolsky (2017) Provide the author, year of publication, title, and publisher of the book. Include any edition information in parentheses after the title, without italics. If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name.

Basic book citation format. The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

Your reference list should include the edition of the book that you read and are relying on for your information. You need to include references to more than one edition only if you read two or more editions of the same book and are using information from each one in your paper. Example. When citing a chapter, the edition number, the volume number (which is different from a journal's volume number), and the page range are all enclosed within the same parentheses—in that order—after the title of the book, and they are separated by commas.
