In inches, common trim sizes for print and self-published books are 5.25 x 8, 5.5 x 8.5 and 6 x 9. Yet you're certainly not limited to these sizes; there are many, many more. Pull out a stack of books and measure them—you'll see that you have options. For books with a lot of text, especially for nonfiction, 6 x 9 is a good choice.

The most common trade paperback sizes are 6"x9" and 5.5"x8.5". You'll also see 5.25"x8" and 5"x8" fairly frequently (as most Print on Demand services allow for them.) Most likely, any of those are basically fine choices for you.
