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The standard cost of the UEFA 'A' licence is €530 in Germany, €1,200 in Spain, €2,350 in Ireland and £4,390 in England. Attaining the 'Pro' licence can cost €7,550 in Ireland and £7,595 in England (figures should be treated with caution as they vary across sources). Also, the courses are relatively time consuming. Under the FAI's programme, the Pro licence requires 250 contact hours over two years, while

the A licence requires 270 contact hours.
