When a source has a corporate author, it is acceptable to use the name of the corporation followed by the page number for the in-text citation. You should also use abbreviations (e.g., nat'l for national) where appropriate, so as to avoid interrupting the flow of reading with overly long parenthetical citations.

To cite an article using APA citation style, start with the author's last name first, followed by a comma, then their first and middle initials. If the article has more than 1 author, list them in the order they appear in the byline of the article.

Start your full citation with the name of the author. If the article has an identified author, provide their last name followed by a comma, then their first name. Place a period after the author's name. If no author is identified, start your citation with the title.

Start by listing the author's last name and first initials, followed by the date of publication in parentheses. Provide the title of the article, but only capitalize the first letter of the title. Next, list the journal or periodical and volume number in italics, followed by the issue number in parentheses.

How to Reference Journal Articles in APA Format

A Listserv, Discussion Group, or Blog Posting Cite web postings as you would a standard web entry. Provide the author of the work, the title of the posting in quotation marks, the web site name in italics, the publisher, and the posting date. Follow with the date of access.

Basic Form APA style dictates that authors are named with their last name followed by their initials; publication year goes between parentheses, followed by a period. The title of the article is in sentence-case, meaning only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized.

Reference List: Articles in Periodicals // Purdue Writing Lab

Online News Article Note: The format for this type of source depends on whether your source comes from a site with an associated newspaper. If the source does come from a site with an associated newspaper, leave the title of the article unformatted, but italicize the title of the newspaper. Lastname, F. M. (Year, Month Date).

Chicago Style Citation Examples. The Chicago/Turabian style of citing sources is generally used when citing sources for humanities papers, and is best known for its requirement that writers place bibliographic citations at the bottom of a page or at the end of a paper.

Author names, if available, will always come first in your reference page for APA citation for journal articles. Start your reference page citation with the last name of the first author followed by a comma, followed by the author's capitalized first initial and a period.

Type the title of the article in title case, capitalizing the first word and all nouns, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs, and verbs. If there is a subtitle, place a colon at the end of the title and then type the subtitle in title case. Place a period at the end, inside the closing quotation marks.

To cite an online journal or newspaper article, the page numbers section from the print journal or newspaper reference is swapped with the URL or DOI the article can be accessed from and when it was accessed. So the reference for an online journal article is: Author surname (s), initial (s).

Basic format for an APA journal citation The article title appears in plain text and sentence case, while the journal name is italicized and in title case (all major words capitalized). Journal articles frequently have multiple authors. Author names should be listed in the order they appear at the head of the article (not in alphabetical order). In your notes, list up to three authors in full. When there are four or more authors, list only the first, followed by " et al. " (Latin for "and others").
