After the heading, the title of the paper is centred on a new line. The heading and title do not take any special styling, and should be the same font and size as the rest of the paper. MLA style does not require a separate cover page. The main body of your paper starts on the same page, directly under the title.

Creating an MLA Heading | What to Include and How to Format It

An MLA-formatted research paper does not need a title page (unless your instructor requires one, of course). Instead, include at the top of your first page a heading – consisting of your name, your instructor's name, the course number, and the date – and the title of your paper. The title should be centered and double-spaced.

The title: After the header, the next double-spaced line should include the title of your paper. This should be centered and in title case, and it should not be bolded, underlined, or italicized (unless it includes the name of a book, in which case just the book title should be italicized).

Many academic research papers, especially those written for language or literature courses, use the citation and formatting style of the Modern Language Association (MLA). When using MLA style, you'll seldom have a separate title page. Instead, provide the same information at the top of the first page of your paper.
